Children studying in panchayat schools never get proper and timely medical care and their parents do not have the money to spend on doctors, medicines and hospitals. Providing medical care to these children who have no access to medical care is the need of the hour.

In a bid to provide healthcare support to the children in the age group of 6-11 years, the Rotary club of Madras and The Cherian Foundation organized a medical camp on 5th August 2006 at Social Service League School. The programme envisages health checkups, providing nutritional supplements and administration of vaccines.

The camp was accomplished with the help of a team of doctors from government hospitals. The children were provided with general physical examination, medical checkups and also done immunization for few.
